

Spring Lake Speedway Point Structure and Breakdown:

Under the point structure for the NASCAR Whelen All-American Series, a race winner receives two points for every car in the event up to 20 cars. Second place receives two fewer points, and so-on through the field. For example, if there are 22 cars, the winner receives 40 points, second gets 38 and third 36. If there are 15 cars, the winner receives 30 points, second gets 28 and third 26. Also, five bonus points are awarded to the winner for a maximum of 45 points per race if the winner started 10th or further back. Otherwise, 3 bonus points are awarded to the winner. Drivers receive points for the feature race only and only a driver's top 14 finishes are counted toward their point total. Spring Lake Speedway is using a very unique point system. We will only be keeping your top 6 points nights out of the season. So if you ran our ten night schedule, you would have then have the option of having your worst nights points thrown out. So it's keeping your best six nights. It is possible for someone to come and run six nights and win our points fund BUT the more nights you race, the more it improves your chances of winning.
